Footnotes

CORONAS AT DELMAR raced off the leaders early, saved ground through the turn, moved up to take command into the stretch and drew off as a handy winner. SHADOW TAMER also raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished with a steady rally. POLO BENDER was away alertly to press the pace from the outside, opened a clear lead with five-sixteenths to run and gave way in the drive. BAGSHOTS DAWN lacked early foot, raced off the rail into the stretch and finished with some late run. MOONLIT MASTER showed no early speed, raced far wide through the turn and did not threaten. MR. HI Q was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from between foes and weakened after going a half. LES CRIME lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not menace. RESTLESS RIVER dueled for the lead from the inside and weakened after a half. CASTLE PINES was bumped at the start, pressed the pace from the outside, bumped with MR. HI Q nearing the three-eighths pole, was taken up soon after, pulled up nearing the wire and walked off. The Stewards conducted an inquiry concerning the bumping of CASTLE PINES at the three-eighths pole and after reviewing the films made no change.
