### Footnotes

HVR WEST CASCADIAN sprinted clear soon after the start, raced off the rail while setting the pace, increased his margin through the back-stretch and drew off through the lane as much the best. LITTLEMAN JOHN raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. DEB'S LEGACY was never far back, raced wide through the second turn and finished evenly in the drive. JACQUELINE'S ANGEL chased the leaders from the inside and gave way after going five furlongs. FAST CHARLI lacked early speed, saved ground through the turns, angled out into the lane and did not menace. SON OF SASSY showed no early speed, raced wide through the second turn and was not a factor.
