**Footnotes**

OFF TO OPERATE broke sharply to duel for the lead from the inside, opened a clear margin with a furlong to run and steadily drew off. OUR ROADRUNNER was bumped at the start, chased the leaders from the outside, angled inside in mid-stretch and finished with good energy. MO'S FLASHY DATE raced off the pacesetters into the lane and finished with late interest. CHARLESISINOPRINCE was bumped at the start, lacked early speed, raced wide through the turn and found his best stride late. MARK THE COP was bumped at the start, dueled for the lead from the outside and gradually gave way. VRONSKY STAR raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and failed to threaten. COUGAR BOB was bumped at the start, raced just off the leaders from the outside and weakened after going a half. CAL'S IMAGE was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and was not a factor. UNBRIDLED TWIN lagged throughout.
