ROCK THE STONE was allowed to settle in stride early, began to work his way forward through the back-stretch, moved outside into the lane, gained command with a furlong to run and steadily drew off. NATIONAL EVENT was off a step slow, showed no early speed, raced wide into the lane and finished with good energy. AMERICAN MOON chased the leaders from between foes, offered a bid nearing the quarter and gave way in the drive. MIKALOUIE went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, drifted out into the stretch and gave way. CLURMOR chased the leaders from the outside and gave way after going six furlongs. RUSTY ROLLS raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the second turn and was not a factor. LOOMING LARGE was away alertly to show brief speed and weakened. JUSTAFIRECRACKER chased the leaders from the inside and weakened after three-quarters.
