LEO THE COP dueled for the lead from the inside, responded when challenged by U O ME with a furlong to run and held HOCK safe late. HOCK raced off the pacesetters early, moved far wide through the turn and finished with a steady rally. U O ME was never far back, angled out approaching the stretch, reached the winner with a furlong to run but could not get by that rival in the drive. TWO SOCKS raced off the leaders early, moved outside through the turn and finished evenly late. VICTORS LEGEND dueled for the lead from the outside for five furlongs and gave way. A J'S BAGDOLL chased the leaders from the outside and gave way gradually in the drive. ILLBEDAZZLINYOU lacked early speed, saved ground throughout and did not reach contention. FIND GOLD showed no early speed, raced off the rail into the stretch and was not a factor. CAHILL SLEW was void of early speed, raced wide through the turn and did not offer a bid.
