RAGGIDY ROWE was unhurried early, ranged into striking distance on the backstretch, swung to the outside leaving the second turn, and was fully extended to wear down his rivals in the final strides. OREGON MERLOT settled racing in hand, got through to launch his bid entering the stretch, loomed large with a furlong to run, but was unable to resist the winner in the final yards. D DEVIL vied for the lead racing two wide, weakened during the drive, but had enough left to hold the show. TRUTH BUSTER stalked the pace racing along the inside, angled out to make a mild bid entering the stretch, but failed to sustain the drive. ABTASTIC set the pressured pace racing along the inside, but weakened entering the stretch and gave way. MY HEARTSON COWBOY passed only his tiring rivals. A COLT NAMED SUE chased the pace racing three wide, but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. LA GRIZZ showed little. SURVIVOR JO was through before going a half.
