PORT MORSBEY quickly got into contention after a slow start, stalking the leaders down the backside and in the far turn for the final time, went to the inside over the final two jumps picking up ground with every stride and prevailed at the wire. ALL TOGETHER was on the pace every step of the way, dueled with PORT MORSBEY and WANTAN (ARG) over the final two fences and gave way in the final strides. WANTAN (ARG) was close up all the way, gained a slight advantage heading into the stretch, and then gave way after the last fence. CLASS INDIAN was in contention for two miles and tired in the stretch. COMPLETE ZEN was never in the race and was no factor here. HISTORY BOY was through after a mile and trailed from there. LAKE PLACID was on the lead when he ran out at the fifth jump leaving the course.
