RUSSIAN KITTEN vied along the rail, bid at the top of the stretch to be clear and held sway in the drive. CHARED'I'S GREAT pressed the pace three wide but couldn't match strides. SHESASHOOTER bore out at the start, stalked the pace four wide and hung in the drive. FLEA MARKET was off awkwardly, saved ground and bid belatedly. DEMA DEVI passed tired rivals. WHAT A SUNSET was off awkwardly. COWBOY CANDY stalked the early pace before fading.
