ROCKEM SOCKEM saved ground, bid at the quarter pole, ducked out from the whip in the stretch and lasted while still lugging out late. MEADOW VESPERS stalked the pace inside, then rallied belatedly. ALL I CAN GET pressed the pace, was steadied slightly at the top of the stretch when the winner came out, then rallied late. A trainer's objection against the winner was disallowed after a stewards' inquiry. IT'S A EGO THING pressed the pace inside, then lacked a late bid. NO TIME TO CRY led inside to the stretch, then gave way. OUT WITH A BANG and KID ATTITUDE were not factors. MY FIRST BUCK faded.
