POOLING PLEASURES was clear early and held sway under a mild drive. SHEZA RIOT stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole but was no match for the winner. COWBOY CANDY bid at the quarter pole, bumped a rival twice near the top of the stretch and improved position late. MYAH'S ROSE stalked the pace between rivals, then lacked a late bid. WHAT A SUNSET was off awkwardly. JET EXPRESS raced four wide and was bumped twice near the three-sixteenths pole. DOC'S ENDEAVOR was not a factor. LUCKIES ACT stalked the pace between rivals, then gave way in the drive. ISLE BE SMOOTH pressed the early pace inside before giving way.
