MOTHERS BAY BOY stalked the early pace four wide, bid at the three-eighths pole and was clear late under a steady drive. GOT YOUR NUGGET bid five wide at the five-sixteenths pole, then gained the place late. NATIVE SOLEIL pressed the pace outside of the leader before giving way late. PIZZA DUDE bid four wide at the half-mile pole before faltering in the drive. BANDON found his best stride late while six wide. NATIVE SKIER pressed the pace four wide, then faded on the far turn. CREATIVE DREAMER stalked the pace five wide,bid at the quarter pole but faltered. GRIEF stalked the pace along the rail before fading on the far turn. GREAT ANNOUNCER vied along the rail for a half mile before giving way.
