ASKHER saved ground, bid at the quarter pole and was up late under a steady drive. GIFT FOR GEO saved ground, rallied on the turn but missed catching the winner. DAYLIGHT JEWEL vied inside, went clear in the drive, but couldn't hold off the winner. THERE'S FIRE stalked the pace four wide, then lacked a late bid. HOLD THAT SUCKER angled out seven wide at the top of the stretch to close late. RUBY'S DIAMOND raced evenly four wide. CAMDEN LADY pressed the pace outside of the leader before fading in the drive. MY OWN DIAMOND saved ground to no avail. GO DEPUTY GO passed tired rivals. KINGSFORD JOY pressed the early pace three wide before fading. DAISIANO unseated the rider while loading, then was off awkwardly. FLOWERS BY DAY was not a factor.
