RED BOW TIE vied four wide and was up late under a drive. COASTING IN vied between rivals, dueled inside through the stretch and was outfinished. LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE improved position late while seven wide. PRINCE OF PAULIE vied outside of a foe, came in at the three-eighths pole to tighten him up and then faded on the turn. WOLSFELD WOODS was off awkwardly. SUB DUE FORCE was off awkwardly, vied inside and was bumped and steadied at the three-eighths pole. NAMOORI vied three wide to the turn before fading.
