Footnotes

MARTANGO led between rivals, then drew off in the stretch under a strong drive. MAMAS ICECREAM MAN rallied six wide at the quarter pole and closed too late. LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE improved position late while five wide. VALENTINUS stalked the pace between rivals, bid at the quarter pole but faded. BANDON stalked the pace between rivals, bid at the three-eighths pole along the rail, then faded in the drive. OFF THE TABLE pressed the pace three wide to the stretch, then gave way. INDEPENDENT ACT was not a factor. WATCH THE BUCKET stalked the early pace four wide, then gave way. TIMELY FACTOR pressed the pace inside for a half mile before giving way.
