**Footnotes**

CUSACK was off awkwardly, rallied eight wide at the three-sixteenths pole and was clear late under a well-timed ride. SPIKE THE DIESEL was clear early along the rail but couldn't hold off the closer. TOPPER TIME stalked the pace four wide, then had a mild late bid while seven wide. SUAVE GENTLEMAN stalked the pace three wide, then had a mild late bid. EL AMIGASO stalked the pace between rivals, then lacked a late bid. I. C. MET saved ground to no avail. CHARLES LARKE saved ground to no avail. ELUSIVE MONSTER raced evenly inside. LAC GRAPE stalked the pace four wide, then faded late. TINQUILCO (CHI) was not a factor. C. C. ODA stalked the early pace between rivals, then faded.
