FOR THREE-YEAR-OLD FILLIES. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$30,000 in 2012 allowed 3 lbs.; non-winners of \$18,000 in 2012 allowed 5 lbs.; \$15,000 at anytime allowed 7 lbs.; \$9,000 at anytime allowed 10 lbs (Maiden and claiming races not considered). No nomination fee. \$350 to pass the entry box and \$500 additional to start. \$60,000 guaranteed of which \$60% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. SUPPLEMENTAL NOMINATIONS AT TIME OF ENTRY WITH AFEE OF \$1,200 TO ENTER AND START. Starters to be named at the usual time of closing. Should this race not be divided and the entry number exceeds twelve (12), high weights will be preferred. Different owners will have equal draw according to weights. The second parts of same owner entries will have no consideration over a single interest. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees.

TAPAJO settled along the inside, waited under a snug hold just behind the pacesetters on the turn, was angled off the rail at the furlong marker for clear run, responded to her cue and edged clear under solid handling. NURSE GOODNIGHT set a contested pace, was headed just inside the furlong pole and stayed on to secure the place spot. APPEALING SUSAN chased the pace while four wide, entered the stretch four wide and finished evenly. WHEN WE BELIEVE forced the pace and was outfinished. HEATED DEBATE failed to menace. HERE COMES POLLY was always outrun. TACTICAL GIRL proved no factor.
