Footnotes

CAMELA CARSON, never far back, was held up just off the pace racing along the inside in the opening quarter, came out to split foes leaving the turn and went clear late under firm handling. GAMBLERS PASSION raced with the pace four wide to the turn, pressed outside foes into upper stretch but proved no match late. DANCEWITHCAPTAIN, close up while racing five wide in the opening quarter, continued to press the issue while four wide on the turn and continued evenly in that path through the stretch. EBONY LADY forced the pace inside rivals from the outset, gained a brief advantage midway on the turn, couldn't sustain that effort and emptied out in the drive. QUEANSCO broke in, brushed SWITCH LANES and never menaced thereafter. SWITCH LANES, brushed at the start, went up to force the pace three wide between foes racing to the bend but gave way after a half.
