Footnotes

KEYSTONE GULCH, brushed by CINTAROSA at the start, was quickly righted to secure a stalking position racing three wide on the backstretch, advanced readily to challenge while still in hand nearing upper stretch, then took charge and held sway through the lane under firm handling. ACAJOU, caught in close quarters stalking the leaders along the inside in the opening quarter, was forced to steady off WINGS ARE THE WAY entering the bend while impeding JAZZY OKIE, was switched out five wide entering upper stretch to challenge and continued well enough to secure the place. JAZZY OKIE ducked inwards at the start, was steadied repeatedly in tight quarters while racing just out of striking distance on the rail through the backstretch, was then forced to check off ACAJOU near the seven sixteenths marker, came off the inside to split foes nearing midstretch and continued willingly for a share. CINTAROSA broke out, brushed the winner, was reserved just outside that rival racing to the bend, made a four wide bid in tandem with that foe nearing upper stretch but flattened out in the drive. NIKKI NINE was hustled to the front from the break, dueled for command along the rail into the turn and gave way in the drive. WINGS ARE THE WAY tracked just off the leaders between foes on the backstretch, angled inwards entering the bend impeding rivals and steadily faded from contention nearing upper stretch. CHEROKEE CAT broke sharply, prompted the pace outside a rival for four furlongs and gave way abruptly. CAPTIVE STORM, extremely reluctant to load, was off awkwardly and never threatened thereafter.
