MR. DEPUTY, reserved in hand just after the start to track the leaders, steadily drew into striking distance on the turn while being angled outside foes, drew abreast of the leader four deep entering upper stretch, was roused clear and widened his margin while being kept to pressure. HELLO SPARKY, unhurried early, made a steady advance outside foes on the turn to gain striking position, gained a narrow advantage between calls late but proved no match for the winner. TWISTER JOHN, close up three wide from the outset, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch, proved no match for the top two and weakened late. KAISER ROAD set the pace along the rail through the backstretch, dueled for command into upper stretch and gave way. WEST LONG BRANCH saved ground tracking the leaders to the lane but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. JOE PEAK disputed the pace between foes racing into the turn but gave way after a half. BALLYGAWLEY LAD tracked just off the first flight on the backstretch but came up empty after a half.
