### Footnotes

STARLET SKY, bumped from both sides at the start, was quickly collected to track the leaders just off the inside through the backstretch, made steady progress on the turn to gain striking distance along the inside, switched out in upper stretch to split foes, then reeled in the pacesetter in the final stages with a sustained rally. LOOKNFORSUMTHINMOR broke out, bumped PATS PEARL, was righted quickly to steadily advance on the first flight three wide, briefly took command in upper stretch but proved second best when confronted by the winner. KINGS TUDOR broke out, bumped the winner, was righted to track the leaders in second flight, came out nearing the lane to challenge but couldn't match the top pair. CHARMING JANIE bobbed at the start, saved ground to the lane tracking the leaders but lacked a visible response. DERBY AFFAIR went quickly to the fore from the break, dueled for command outside a rival to upper stretch and gave way. ELITE LADY was hustled along the inside to join a rival on the pace, dueled for command into the turn and gave way in the drive. PRIVATE OPERATOR tracked outside foes unhurried to the turn but passed only tiring rivals. TOUGH BETH never seriously menaced. NOT ENOUGH DANCING showed little. PATS PEARL, bumped at the start, soon dropped out. DELMAR DIVA broke inwards bumping the winner at the start, recovered to briefly track the pace between foes but gave way abruptly after a half.
