STOUT HOPE assumed command from the outset, was headed entering the stretch but responded to confident handling and edged clear in the final sixteenth. BG SILVER SNOW settled in mid-pack, lodged a bid around the far turn, gained the lead approaching the three-sixteenths marker and kept on despite proving no match. FROGGYVILLE raced in striking position, moved three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. FUTURE DIRECTION prompted the pace nearest the rail, was outpaced around the far turn and had no rally. BIG KISS outrun early, angled off the rail up the backstretch run and failed to threaten in the stretch. ANTRIM COUNTY never menaced. SHAWCOLATADDICTION proved no factor. WOULD YOU was off a step slow and never involved.
