Footnotes

KELA'S ASSAULT stalked the pace, responded into the stretch and held sway under steady pressure. KENTUCKY JONES reserved early, lodged a bid around the far turn, leaned out at the furlong marker under left-handed pressure brushing WHAT A CHESTNUT and rallied willingly thereafter. BITTER CREEK saved ground, angled out four wide for the stretch run and had no rally. WHAT A CHESTNUT outpaced while four wide, advanced on the far turn, was brushed nearing the furlong marker and tired. FRIEND OF INDY grabbed the early lead, was headed on the far turn and gave way. ELEVEN GAGE was sluggish early and proved no factor. KENTUCKY THUMBS UP raced in striking position while four wide and faded.
