Footnotes

WILLA CATHER, reserved well off the pace in the opening quarter, slowly drew into striking distance midway through the bend, was swung seven wide entering the lane, then swept to the front in the final furlong to go clear late under firm handling. PJ'S HALO, unhurried early, made a steady advance racing five wide through the bend, drifted in and brushed REFLECTED IMAGE approaching the sixteenth pole but continued well enough to secure the place. BONITA ROSE broke slowly, saved ground tracking the pace into the turn, angled off the inside to split foes in upper stretch and was gaining well late. REFLECTED IMAGE tracked the leaders from the outside, made a steady gain four wide on the turn to challenge, was brushed in late stages and flattened out. FAIR AND GREY chased the pace racing four wide on the backstretch, advanced to force the tempo on the turn but gave way in the drive. KISSAME angled inwards soon after the start, prompted the pace between foes, edged clear entering upper stretch but couldn't contain her rivals in the last furlong. EMILY'S RARE TRICK tracked just off the first flight along the inside but lacked a closing response. WITHE was off slowly and never menaced. WINONA tracked the pace between foes and faded steadily nearing the turn. SUPPLY HOUSE was hustled up the inside to challenge for command and gave way abruptly midway through the turn. BLONDE'S REALITY was under pressure from the outset chasing the pace but was through early.
