Footnotes

BULLARA raced in striking position while three wide, took over approaching the quarter mile marker, forged clear and held well into the stretch. SOUTHERN SAVVY reserved early, advanced five wide around the far turn, moved five wide into the stretch and stayed on well. THAT I AM was outrun early but rallied through traffic in the stretch run. PRIME REALESTATE chased the pace between foes, entered the stretch three wide, leaned in at the furlong marker and offered a bid. COME IN ALMIGHTY outpaced while four wide, was urged around the far turn and outfinished. MERCURY EXPRESS passed tired ones. NORTH OF TIME prompted the pace and weakened. SMOKEY AROMA set the pace, faded into the stretch run and was steadied when in tight at the furlong marker. HAYMOW BOB saved ground and managed no rally. FOLLOWING THE RACE, THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO AN INCIDENT NEARING THE FURLONG MARKER. AFTER REVIEWING VIDEOTAPED REPLAYS, THEY DISQUALIFIED PRIME REALESTATE AND PLACED HIM 8TH FOR INTERFERING WITH SMOKEY AROMA.
