SUMTHINTOTALKABOUT secured striking distance soon after the start, advanced readily three wide to collar the pacesetter, wrested command nearing the furlong marker and drew clear late under steady encouragement. STAR OF ESTON quickly sped clear along the inside, set the pace nearest the rail to upper stretch, proved no match for the winner and just lasted for the place. TRISHA RUNS, off a bit awkwardly, was hustled to a contending position, dueled for command between foes midway through the turn, but weakened in the final eighth. BUCK'S BEST chased the leaders racing four wide through the backstretch and couldn't close the gap in the closing stages. SHARKY'S REVIEW settled well off the pace in the opening three furlongs, then came around some tiring foes in the lane while having little impact. AMBERSENT tracked the leaders on the inside to the turn, then emptied out nearing upper stretch. LADY TAMWORTH was settled along the rail on the backstretch, saved ground to the lane and lacked a further rally. I'M A CITY GIRL raced unhurried outside rivals and never gained striking distance. SHARKY BONO was quickly outdistanced and walked off under her own power.
