MONROE WILDCAT stalked the early pace from the outside, steadily crept closer entering the turn, responded when sat down for the drive and steadily drew clear. MR. CHILLIP chased the early pace from between foes, made a bid but could not reach the winner. DREW BOY well placed from the inside, inched closer entering the turn, responded but could not sustain the effort. RAPIDO CORREDOR chased the early pace from the outside, made a bid and closed well late. RACE CAR RED forced the early pace outside and tired. CHASING GLITTER was no factor. HUM ALONG MARA went evenly. STROLL ON BYE dueled from the inside and tired. EXCITING CAT was outrun. LOUDEN was never a factor and eased after a half and vanned off.
