BACK TO GOLD settled while three wide, swung five wide into the stretch and finished willingly. MY NEPHEW MATT sprinted clear, held well into the stretch and was worn down late. SLEW CITY GOLD bobbled at the start, saved ground, remained inside for the stretch run and managed a mild bid. TIP OF THE LAKE void of speed, entered the stretch four wide and showed some late energy. BATESVILLE was forwardly placed and dropped back on the turn. CITY TRAIN failed to menace. HOLY BULLHIVE was always outrun. STRATOS was never involved.
