VEILLIT' settled well, advanced on the far turn, moved three wide into the stretch and kicked clear. TWO BAYME reserved early, entered the stretch four wide and rallied. MINNESOTA THUNDER forwardly placed, lost her position on the far turn and stayed on for a minor share in the stretch. ABYDOS gained the lead, was headed at the eighth pole and gave way. JEFFELL outrun, swung five wide into the stretch and passed tiring rivals. EXTRACT never menaced. KISS AND FLY chased while five wide early, moved up to stalk up the backstretch run and faltered in the stretch. BERYOZKA saved ground and faded.
