Footnotes

ONLY AT NIGHT bobbed at the start then was bumped by SUPPLY HOUSE, quickly recovered under pressure to join the leaders, took command racing into the turn, dueled for command along the rail and gamely held the challenge of SCENIC WON to prevail. The latter ducked inwards at the start, was quickly righted, angled out in the opening quarter while drawing into striking distance, pressed the pace through the turn and into the lane but came up second best. AMBERSENT tracked the leaders along the inside, came out racing into the lane and continued to improve her placing. RASCAL'S LYNNIE, prominent outside foe from the break, chased the pacesetter for three furlongs and gave way. KIDS 'N CATS tracked the leaders in second flight to the bend but couldn't produce the necessary closing bid. SHARKY BONO hopped in the air at the start, lost position and never regained contention. SUPPLY HOUSE reared at the start, broke inwards bumping the winner, was collected to make a brief, four wide bid racing into the turn but soon dropped out.
