CASE OF CASH grabbed the early lead, held well into the stretch, drew off thereafter in a good effort. I VOW TO WIN settled well, advanced on the turn, entered the stretch three wide and stayed on well. SIX GUN SMOKIN reserved along the inside, angled four wide into the stretch and rallied. CYCLONEONTHEOASIS awkward at the start, was outpaced, swung six wide into the stretch and flashed late energy. C. M.'S SONG was forwardly placed and offered no response. THE CLIFF'S END passed tiring rivals. PREMIUM OPTION was brushed at the start and proved no factor. CRESCO DIRECT HIT stalked the early pace and weakened. LETS JUST SAY staged a steady retreat. WEST ALBANY showed little.
