SHIFTY SHERIFF forced the pace, moved to the front on the turn and held sway in the stretch under right-handed pressure. WILSON RIVER settled well, swung five wide into the stretch and rallied. ZEE THRONE off slowly, was reserved, angled in for the stretch and finished well. ALPHA GUY reserved behind the pace, moved four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed bid. SHARP ALBERT raced forwardly while four wide, challenged the winner on the turn and weakened. LOUZADO never menaced. DENALI BIRDSTONE dueled early and dropped back on the turn. CAT'S MEMORY MAKER vied for the lead between foes, was squeezed back when in tight at the seven-sixteenths marker, checked as a result and failed to recover. TRICKY SKY PILOT took no part.
