PESCADERO reserved early, commenced his bid on the far turn, moved five wide into the stretch and rallied under a drive. EPICURUS taken in hand, moved closer on the far turn, rallied four wide but could not contain the top one. SING IN THE STORM chased the pacesetter, entered the stretch three wide and stayed on. MIZZEN MAZE seized command, held well into the stretch and gave way in the final furlong. ALL READY saved ground and offered no contending bid. SMOKEY AROMA settled while five wide, advanced on the far turn and flattened out in the stretch. WILD UNION took no part. BEAN stalked the pace while four wide and dropped back on the far turn.
