ELISHA JOY was outrun to the stretch, angled out in upper stretch, closed willingly through the lane and won going away under urging. BROKE TRYING raced three wide in midpack to the stretch, finished willingly to gain the place late. MISS DENOUNCER raced close up while three wide to the stretch, bid between rivals a sixteenth out, was outfinished. HOT JELLY JAM saved ground chasing the pacesetters to the stretch, finished evenly and narrowly missed the minor awards. COOPER'S SONG set the pace from the rail without pressure to midstretch before weakening late. I'M A CITY GIRL saved ground racing within range to the stretch, moved closer in upper stretch but failed to produce the needed late bid. GLOWING WEST threw her head leaving the gate and was away slowly, showed little thereafter. HAWLEY LAKE chased from the two path to the stretch before tiring.
