T. C. CHAMP saved ground, took over on the far turn and drew off in the stretch under intermittent pressure. CONSIDER void of speed, angled three wide into the stretch and lodged a late bid. BROKEN FREE outpaced while three wide, moved three wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. REWIRING forwardly placed, made a bid on the far turn but came up empty. SMOKEY AROMA sprinted clear, was headed on the far turn and yielded. THREE PARK NIGHT was outrun and faltered.
