BLAKE RATTLENROLL dueled inside a rival on the backstretch, went clear on the turn, maintained his advantage to midstretch and held sway late under urging despite failing to switch leads through the drive. LITTLE AFFAIR stalked the winner to the stretch and finished willingly while easily besting the rest. SUNDAY SINS raced well back early, advanced to contention racing four deep on the turn, finished evenly and just saved third. OUR LAST TURN raced in midpack to the stretch and did not rally. SEA FOX raced four wide while well back on the turn, passed several tired rivals through the lane. SHARKY RAJA raced four wide in midpack on the turn and never threatened. HUNT N HAY saved ground racing within striking range on the turn but gave way through the drive. MR. ETHANOL was never a factor. PANCHO GEM checked from tight quarters approaching the turn and dropped back. CAT ROCK dueled outside of the winner to the turn, faltered. COASTIN C was outrun. KING FORTUNATE raced close up along the rail early before retreating on the turn.
