UNUSUAL SYNDROME saved ground racing well off the pace to the stretch, angled out slightly for racing room in midstretch, rallied strongly and powered past the runner up late to win going away. TUFF JUSTICE stalked the dueling leaders to the turn, angled out three wide midway on the bend, rallied to challenge in upper stretch, fought to a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker but could not contain the winner late. QUEANSCO trailed while saving ground to the stretch, angled out while rallying in the final sixteenth and finished strongly. ONDA RAY raced in midpack to the stretch before putting in a late rally. MISS BARBARA RAY dueled from the two path to inside the final furlong before weakening late. SHADOW DANCE raced four wide in midpack on the turn and finished evenly. PROVEN HONOR raced within striking range off the inside to the stretch but failed to produce a bid. SHESA PRIVATE I dueled along the rail to midstretch before tiring. MAGIC WEAPON was never a factor. SECRET PACKAGE raced four wide on the turn and showed little.
