JIFFY WISH settled off the early pace, made a three wide bid on the second turn, dueled outside of the runner up to the final furlong before inching clear late under urging. FIRECARD was hung out four wide while moving up around the first turn, advanced to chase the pacesetter from the two path on the backstretch, bid from between rivals and stuck a head in front midway on the second turn, dueled inside of the winner through the lane but could not match strides late. BAYAKOA'S IMAGE chased the pace from the rail to the stretch before weakening. DANCE RHYTHM went clear on the first turn, was headed entering the second turn, tired through the lane. MADAM PERSUASIVE raced between rivals in the second flight on the backstretch, began to drop back on the second turn. TRUE TEAR DROPS was outrun. MISS VALEDICTORIAN was pulling hard around the first turn and into the backstretch, showed little thereafter.
