R'S STAR was unhurried racing near the back of the pack around the first turn, commenced his rally while four wide on the final turn, took a narrow lead in upper stretch, dueled outside of the runner up through the lane and prevailed under left handed urging. BUCK'S APPEAL stalked the pace while saving ground to the stretch, bid inside rivals in upper stretch, dueled through the lane but could not match the winner late. BACCALAUREATE raced between rivals from the two path in midpack to the final turn, went evenly through the lane. SPEED ROUSER dueled from the two path to midstretch before weakening. SPRING TRAINING was unhurried along the rail early, moved within range on the final turn but failed to produce a bid. QUICK BLEND raced close up while three wide on the first turn, tracked the dueling leaders up the backstretch, made a bid on the final turn, dueled to the stretch before tiring. DE TOBY was outrun. POINT BREEZE dueled along the rail for the first half mile before retreating quickly approaching the final turn.
