THATS A GOOD THING stalked the early pace from the inside, advanced up the backstretch, reached a striking position entering the second turn, split rivals, dueled through the drive and outfinished WINTER SUMMIT late. WINTER SUMMIT broke well from the outside to gain a clear early margin, dueled through the drive with the winner but was outfinished in a game effort. LOAFERS GLORY dueled from between foes early, dueled through the stretch but could not keep pace. LAST MARTINI chased the early pace from between foes, made a bid entering the drive and was gaining late. MOONING YOU forced the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. PRINCE HOPE could only pass tired ones. QUINTONS SPEEDY could only improve position. TEXAS ROGUE had a steady fade. SLIGO INCOGNITO was never close. AGENT DUDLEY forced the early pace and gave way.
