SWAGE reserved early, advanced on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch and rallied under stiff pressure. PETITION FOR GOLD dueled, edged clear on the turn, kept on well but was worn down. WHY FRANK void of speed, commenced his bid on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and lodged a bid. CROSS HAMMERS reserved behind the pace while under restraint, angled in for the stretch run, lacked room from the quarter mile marker to the sixteenth pole and lacked a finishing punch. TEZ VIRAT vied for the between rivals and weakened. BIGELOW BILL raced in striking position while four wide and weakened. I REMEMBER HARLIN was always outrun. TUFF COWBOY proved no factor.
