KELA'S ASSAULT settled while four wide, advanced on the turn, continued four wide into the stretch and rallied. BACK TO GOLD reserved, commenced a bid on the turn and stayed on in the stretch. AWESOME STREET chased along the inside and lacked a rally. TIP OF THE LAKE showed mild late interest. CHOP SLEWY proved no factor. COOPER JUNIOR never menaced. BATESVILLE stalked the pace and weakened. STORMIN AL was awkward at the start and always outrun.
