JACKIE BLU grabbed the lead, held well into the stretch, responded to brisk pressure and edged clear late. SAND SCRIPT stalked, was outpaced into the stretch, proved no match but stayed on well. GRACEFUL BERT saved ground, lodged a bid on the turn, angled out three wide at the three-sixteenths marker and kept on. BLUE BOY BLUE was forwardly placed and lacked a rally. MADRID MACHO MAN reserved, advanced on the turn, moved five wide into the stretch and flattened out. RUNNING COMMANDO settled, lost his position on the turn, angled in for the stretch run and posed no threat. FORGET TO REMEMBER outrun, swung six wide into the stretch and displayed some late interest. LETS GO CONDOR showed little. JAMMIN JIMMY was awkward at the start, veered in early and proved no factor.
