DON'T JINX IT came in at the start bumping COUNT ON BILL, immediately took control and remained clear throughout under steady handling. COUNT ON BILL was bumped at the start by the eventual winner, settled, moved up while five wide in the stretch but made no impact. NO MORE BORSCH was void of early speed but rallied three wide through the stretch to finish a remote third. HALF A RUMOR raced forwardly while five wide, moved into second at the top of the stretch and faltered thereafter. TELL BRETT was outrun early and never menaced. LITTLE WAGON saved ground to no avail. EXPLAINED chased the early pace in vain and dropped back on the far turn. ED'S PRIZE CAT chased the early pace between rivals and tired badly upon going a half mile.
