TRICKY TETON forced the pace, took over on the turn and drew off in the stretch run under intermittent pressure. SIR RICHEY saved ground, maneuvered off the rail in the stretch and closed ground. CIELO FIVE reserved, moved four wide into the stretch and lodged a mild bid. EL BORREGO raced in striking position while four wide and lacked a rally. PAT'S MAGIC vied for the lead between foes, was on the urged turn and offered no response. CHASING GLITTER stumbled badly at the start and proved no factor. DOCTOR KIP never menaced. T L S LIGHTNING was always outrun. HUMMINATUNE prompted the pace and faltered.
