JULIES FIRST raced four wide within range on the turn, rallied to the front approaching midstretch and widened while being ridden out to the wire despite failing to switch leads through the lane. HOT JELLY JAM raced in midpack to the stretch, finished willingly and easily bested the rest. MIKAY AS LADY dueled from the two path, inched clear approaching the stretch, was overtaken by the winner in midstretch and tired. BROKE TRYING raced three wide on the turn and was never a factor. COOPER'S SONG dueled along the rail to the final quarter of a mile before tiring. BRODNICKI broke in the air and was away slowly, was outrun. GLOWING WEST was outrun. HAWLEY LAKE raced close up while three wide to the turn before retreating.
