Footnotes

LIL BRIAN TOO up close early from between rivals, crept closer entering the turn, responded when asked and wore down front running DUFOURSPLITZE the final furlong. DUFOURSPLITZE broke sharp from the outside to gain a clear early margin, remained clear entering the turn, held a short advantage at the eighth pole but could not last. ALKINOOS outrun early, made a bid entering the stretch and had good energy late. SPIRIT OF WINTER chased the early pace outside but had nothing left for the drive. TOMCAT ROW chased the pace from the inside but had no late response. PRIZE OF THE CITY was finished early. RED FALCON went evenly. STREAK was no factor.
