Footnotes

TRIED TO BE GRAY stalked the dueling leaders while saving ground to the stretch, angled off the inside in upper stretch, rallied to collar the leaders in the final sixteenth and drew clear late under urging. HAPPY IN REALITY was unhurried early, saved ground to the stretch, steadied behind the winner when that one angled out approaching the furlong marker, split horses late and finished strongly to gain the place at the wire. KEY TO MONTANA dueled on the inside of a three horse spread to the stretch, continued willingly but was outfinished late. SHOW TICKET stalked the dueling leaders to the second turn, moved up to challenge for and take a narrow lead while three wide around that bend, dueled to midstretch but was also outfinished. ALY PERFORMER stumbled badly at the start fell far back, trailed to the second turn, found her best stride through the lane and finished strongly but too late. KENTUCKY GIRL raced five wide entering the first turn, angled inward on the backstretch, advanced to contention on the second turn while between horses, but failed to produce a late bid. CERISTIC was never a factor. ALARMING FABLE dueled from between horses to the stretch before tiring. MS FANCY PANTS raced five wide on the first turn in midpack, showed little thereafter. BELL dueled for command while three wide to the second turn before faltering. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner up against the winner for alleged interference in midstretch was not allowed.
