CHAMPAGNE LUNCH grabbed the lead, held well into the stretch and pulled away readily. DAYJUR WHO raced in striking position while three wide, remained three wide into the stretch, kept on but was no match. CLASSY MISRATA outpaced, was urged on the turn, moved four wide into the stretch, lugged in during the stretch run and stayed on. MISS VASHTI veered in at the start, saved ground, was angled three wide at the furlong marker and lodged a bid. VOODOO WHO chased inside and lacked a rally. PRETTY GIRL PLAYER bobbled at the start, was bumped early by the errant MISS VASHTI, chased five wide and posed no threat. GLITTERS GONE WILD was outrun. MAYBE SOMEDAY BABY retreated. LU BIRD showed little.
