OUR BOY KEN bobbed at the start, dueled early, took over into the stretch and held sway thereafter. TEARNUPTHUNDER outrun early, swung four wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. WOO PIG SOOIE forced the pace, moved to the front up the backstretch run but was worn down late. ON A BURNER was void of speed and showed some late interest. THATS RAY'S TIGER was settled three wide and failed to threaten. ALPHA GUY raced forwardly along the inside and faltered.
