I WISHED saved ground and lacked a rally. CELINA DIAMOND chased and failed to threaten. HESA RAZORBACK never menaced. CHEAP CHOCOLATE was always outrun. SUSPECTING FIRE showed little. LA SORTA stalked the pace and faltered.
